FREE PARKING ON ALL 3 CAMPUSES

- > UW Bothell:
 - Register your car online ahead of each visit
 - Email UWRA (<u>retiremt@uw.edu</u>) for the link
- > UW Tacoma:
 - Complete this form: retirees.uw.edu/uwt-retiree-parking
 - Good for one year

COMPLIMENTARY PARKING AT UW SEATTLE

- > On the day you're coming to campus:
 - Show your retiree Husky card at a staffed gate
 - OR Use your Husky netID to reserve online at the customer portal
 - See the transportation website above for a list of lots

COMPLIMENTARY PARKING AT UW SEATTLE

- > Spouse/partner may use your privilege (one car per household at a time only)
- > You may move your car from lot to lot
- > Park anywhere space is available (unrestricted lots; see link above for list)

ONLINE CUSTOMER PORTAL

- > Obtain a parking permit through the Customer Portal: uwts.t2hosted.com/account/portal
- > Choose 'UW Login' and use your netID & password
 - The parking system will recognize that you are a retiree
 - Permit will be linked to your vehicle license plate(s)

RETIREE DISABILITY PARKING (UW SEATTLE)

- > Stop by a staffed gatehouse to get an accessible/disability permit that allows you to park in a disability stall
- > Must display UW- or State- issued disability placard

RETIREE EVENT PARKING (UW SEATTLE)

- > See transportation.uw.edu/park/events/calendar for lots with temporary event fees (or look for signs at the lot)
- > If a lot has an event fee, complimentary retiree parking is <u>not</u> available in that lot

RETURNING FOR REEMPLOYMENT?

- > Options
 - Rehired for 40% FTE or less: discounted SOV permit or pay daily
 - Rehired for more than 40% FTE: pay regular employee rates
 - Rehired but on campus for a non-work reason: use the free parking privilege
- > Before noon on Saturday and after 5 pm on weekdays
 - Park free regardless of reemployment status
- > After noon on Saturday and all day on Sunday
 - Everyone parks free

REGIONAL REDUCED FARE PERMIT

Reduced transit fares for riders over 65 (King, Pierce, Snohomish Counties)

- > Not run by UW Transportation Services
- > Obtain the RRFP ORCA card for free.
- > With the RRFP ORCA card, pay \$1 for Metro bus rides and light rail rides
- > Available on Puget Sound transit systems (Metro buses, Access, water taxi, streetcar, light rail, Monorail, Sound Transit, Sounder, Community Transit, Everett Transit, etc.)
- > Obtain your card in person or by email
 - Available at Metro's Customer Service Information Office (King Street Center)
 - ORCA To-Go Mobile Events
 - Other transit agencies
